BTAS is a wholesale arrangement where Frontier provides ADSL and internet access over a local loop.

Authentication will be forwarded to ISP RADIUS server for PPP negotiation.

Provisioning

Frontier DSLAMs will be provisioned at the following speeds for ADSL (dynamic IP):

- 10Mb/768Kb
- 6Mb/768Kb (where available)
- 3Mb/768Kb
- 768Kb/256Kb

Ordering

All ordering activity for BTAS must be requested through email via the DSL Order Form. Requests should be emailed to wbbc@frontiernet.net. Once an order has been placed, the provisioning office will return the DSL Order Form with appropriate response information.

Frontier does not support electronic transactions for BTAS.

Billing

BTAS will be billed on a separate fictitious billing account to the ISP for each end-user. Each account will be assigned to an ISP summary master. ISPs may arrange to view or receive the billing statements in electronic formats.
