Frontier provides notice that that the hardware update as communicated in Bulletin CCBFTR00172 on November 8<sup>th</sup> that is further described below, has been cancelled. Work will resume at a future date to be communicated via Bulletin.

The IP Addresses seen from E-bonded customers will continue to be 170.215.33.109 and 170.215.33.110 as per current operating state, described below.

Thank you to the customers who tested with Frontier the morning of November 20<sup>th</sup>. Please watch for further notice regarding these architecture plans.

**Current State:**

Customers connect to Frontier today using virtual ip address 66.133.172.142, which is load balanced and spreads their traffic between the two production servers.

Source address seen by the customers and allowed through their firewalls is 170.215.33.109 and 170.215.33.110. The source address is the 170.215 address due to a limitation on the current load balancer.

**Future State:**

The Load balancer limitation is removed. Going forward Frontier will mask the individual EP servers via the same virtual IP 66.133.172.142 address they connect to for inbound requests.
