Effective Date: On or after March 1, 2012

On July 29, 2011, Frontier announced its intent to make doing business with Frontier easier and more consistent, by converting the Operational Support Systems (OSS) and ordering processes used in the remaining nine of the Frontier 13 states, to the existing Frontier Legacy and/or Acquired West Virginia systems and processes. Frontier filed an Operations Support Systems Integration Plan with the FCC on July 29, 2011 see [Frontier 13 System Conversion](#).

In 66-Days from December 26, 2011, Frontier will sunset the Frontier 13 OSS systems used in Arizona, California, Idaho, Illinois, Nevada, Ohio, Oregon, Washington, Wisconsin, on or after March 1, 2012.
