



## Jeopardy Codes

A Jeopardy indicates the risk of missing a confirmed due date and/or the need to provide additional information required to process the request. The below table identifies the jeopardy codes and explanations of the code.

1A	=	Inter Office Facility Shortage
1B	=	Scheduling/Work Load
1C	=	Customer Not Ready
1D	=	No Loop Available
1E	=	End User Not Ready
1F	=	Provider Missed Appointment
1G	=	No Access to End User Premise
1H	=	Central Office Freeze
1J	=	Special Construction
1K	=	Natural Disaster (Flood, etc.)
1L	=	Frame Due Time Cannot Be Met
1M	=	Due Date Cannot Be Met
1N	=	Due Date and Frame Due Time Cannot Be Met
1P	=	Other
1Q	=	Assignment Problem
1R	=	Customer Could Not Be Reached
1S	=	Building Not Ready, Customer Will Advise
1T	=	Pole At Site Not Set
1U	=	Cancel Per Customer
1V	=	No Facilities
1W	=	Entrance Facilities Required
1X	=	Not Technically Feasible
1Y	=	No Central Office Equipment Available
1Z	=	Other Exchange Company Not Ready
